Dear Coach

It's that time of year for us (Chuck Rolinski-IBCA) to start working on the ICCA's Annual Cheerleading Championship Program. We have produced the last 15 beautiful programs, and we'll do the 26th annual ICCA program this year.

However, we have a major change once again. The ICCA had to move the championships up almost one month. This year it will be Feb. 13 & 14th.

Therefore, I really think you should start working now on a possible ad by 1st - getting your picture ready and anticipate your qualifying for the finals.

The ads will have to be in almost one month earlier than they were 3-years ago. The last week in January and the 1st week in February, the qualifying dates will be in Nov., Dec. and early January. We hope we can count on your support if you qualify to make this once again a beautiful program.

Now, the ICCA will also have their regular ICCA Championships for Jr. High, Jr. Varsity and Varsity Teams with 2 main changes and additions. They will have 2 new Divisions for Varsity and Jr. High in addition to their regular competition.

1st Division - Game cheer division, just regular game routines, this will be for many varsity and Jr. High teams that do not practice competitive routines.

2nd - group stunt division

3rd - Contrary to what some Northern A.D.'s are telling their teams, you can compete in the ICCA event Springfield because your season does not end until March 31st. This statement came from the IHSA office from Susan Knoblauch who is in charge of the IHSA Cheerleading division

There are several changes this year:

* 1st - Do not send camera ready ads. Please use E-mail or send to me the actual pictures and information. Write the name or names on the back of the picture.

2nd - The picture can be black & white or color, either way. The background is the key. Black hair in the black background is not good.

3rd. - Payment can be made now or please send within 3 weeks. Make checks payable to the IBCA.

If you send the ad by e-mail, the printer, Bill Sondag and his assistant on this book, Mary Sheets, prefer you send the information or lay-out on PDF Files and the pictures by JPEG. Also, please call Bill at 309-246-2865 to make sure he got the e-mail. You can also call me but please call Bill or Mary to make sure the e-mail came through and if there are any problems with the e-mail, he can clear this up with you. His E-mail address is sonbtp@aol.com.

So, all you have to do is type or print what you want on the ad. You can use last year's All-Star program ads as a guide. You can put any honors and information that you want in the ad. Make sure you list the sponsors. Then, send that copy with a picture or pictures to me at our address: IBCA, Box 372, Toluca, IL 61369. If you use UPS or Fed-X use the 106 South Main, Toluca IL 61369 or E-mail sonbtp@aol.com directly to the printer. E-Mail is the best right now. Use PDF file and JPEG for the pictures.

The next major change is one that the Board of Directors agreed on. That is, we would like to get a full page or a 1/2 page or a double page on each unit. Each squad is being asked to obtain a group of sponsors for their page or 1/2 page. Each full page is \$250 and a 1/2 page is \$160 and a double page is \$475. To get your team picture in the program, you must take an ad.

We will list all the sponsors on your page or pages. You may put individual pictures also instead of a team picture, or with your team picture. (You don't need a picture but pictures make the ad look much nicer.)

We hope to get this letter out to all Cheerleading Coaches with a copy of the 2009 ICCA All-Star program during the school year, so work can begin on the ads. Check your ICCA Web site.
